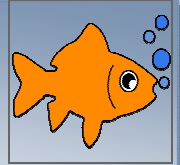

Home School Connections:

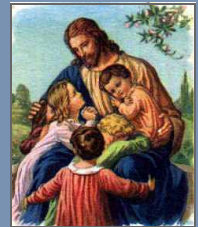
Home connections are great ways to incorporate what was learned at school and what can be taught at home. A good way to practice learning the letter "Vv" is by writing the letter. Show your child how to make a "Vv" this way: V and v: Make a sliding board that slants down to the right then make a line that slants back up to the right. You could also play a listening game with your child. Whenever they hear a word that starts with the letter "Vv" have them clap their hands or put their hands on their belly.
